**Government Order**

No. 4648-ER-I-2014/ 13117,      Dated: 11 September 2014

**Subject:      Provision for Relief Assistance for the flood affected people of the State of Jammu & Kashmir.**

The Government of Haryana has decided to supplement and extend some immediate Relief Assistance to the people of Jammu & Kashmir adversely affected by the recent floods. The expenditure on the procurement, packing, loading, dispatch, and transportation of the relief material shall be met out of the Haryana Chief Minister's Relief Fund.

2. It has been decided that the procurement and supply of various items for relief assistance for the flood affected people of Jammu & Kashmir would be done to meet emergency conditions and, as such, the normal procurement procedures and rules of the Government will not be applicable for these arrangements. However, it is expected that the concerned authorised officers will exercise their prudence in the procurements and supplies of these items.

3. It has been decided to designate the Deputy Commissioner, Panipat as the nodal officer to make arrangements for procurement, packing, loading and transportation of 50,000 blankets as a part of the Relief Package. As such, the Deputy Commissioner Panipat is authorised to:

- (i) to make arrangements for procurement of 50,000 blankets of reasonably good quality for the purpose from various manufacturers and suppliers based in Panipat;
- (ii) to constitute any sub-committee of local officers or associate any Association or representative body of local manufacturers to assist him in sourcing & packing the requisite number of blankets from various manufacturers;
- (iii) to decide on the quality standards and determine the rates thereof.

4. The Deputy Commissioner Panipat would also make arrangements for loading and transportation of the consignments of blankets, which would be sent at the Cargo Division of AIR India at New Delhi Airport for shipment to Srinagar. The Nodal person from Air India is one Mr. R. D. Singh- Contact No. +91-9910047009. The ACS & Resident Commissioner Haryana at Haryana Bhawan would coordinate and inform about the person receiving the consignment on behalf of the Government of J&K at the Delhi Airport after discussions with his counterpart of the J&K Government.

5. It has been further decided to procure and dispatch some basic medicines, milk powder and ready-to-eat/ dry food items as part of the relief assistance for the people of J&K. Necessary action in this behalf would be taken as under:

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- 5.1 The Director General, Health Services, would arrange to collect various basic medicines (he has identified 45 such medicines), which are on the Rate Contract and estimated to cost about Rs. 50-60 lakh) and available in the different stores of Health Department within next two days and keep the same in a ready- to- dispatch condition at a short notice at Gurgaon. The Department would, thereafter, submit its bills for these medicines which would be recouped from the Chief Minister's Relief Fund.
- 5.2 As regards the other items, it has been decided that the State would also consider sending (i) Dry Milk Powder (to be sourced from/ through Haryana Co-operative Dairy Federation and other sources like the NDRI etc.) and (ii) Dry Food Items (to be organised by the Principal Secretary, Food & Civil Supplies). Any other items of relief to be sent may be decided on the basis of need.
6. Keeping in view that the relief assistance items may continue to be provided for a few days in a row, it has been decided to designate Sh. P.K. Das, Principal Secretary, Social Justice & Empowerment Department, as the State's Nodal Officer and Task Leader, authorized and empowered to get in touch with various sources, issue directions to officers from various departments/ officers in view of his rich experience and efficient handling of relief assistance operations on last two-three occasions. Sh. P.K. Das has been authorized to take any decisions in this behalf, of which he may submit a weekly report to the Chief Secretary/ Chief Minister for approval/ ratification of decisions taken by him in this behalf. All officers shall extend their immediate assistance to him in the efficient discharge of his duties for this noble cause.
7. This order issues with the approval of the Chief Minister, Haryana.


