

Subject: Security arrangements to be made during the visits of dignitaries/Protectees during their visits abroad - reg.

I am directed to state that in a meeting held recently in the Ministry of External Affairs on the subject mentioned above, the issue of delay in sharing the schedule of programme of dignitaries / protectees visiting abroad was also discussed. Our missions abroad often do not get sufficient time to inform the local police/security agencies so as to ensure requisite security arrangements for the visiting dignitaries/protectees. Many a times the shared information are incomplete and do not include details relating to the itinerary, place of stay or local contacts compounding the problems of the Missions.

Since our Embassies/Posts are required to liaise with the foreign authorities Governments at multiple levels, it is requested that all the State Governments/UT Administration may communicate the dignitaries'/protectees' foreign travel programme with MEA at least 10 days in advance before the scheduled date of departure.
