Dear Shri Roshan Lal,

I would like to apprise you that the Prime Minister's National Council on Skill Development (Now NSDA) has set a target of providing skills to 17 lakh youth in Haryana during the 12th five year plan i.e. 2012-17. Skill targets to be achieved in both the formal as well as informal sector are as under:-

If the Departments/ Organizations entrusted with the task, continue to work on the present scale, it will not be possible to achieve the targets. We have to enhance our existing training/ skilling capacity from 2,30,000 to 3,50,000 during the current financial year/ academic session i.e. 2014-15 and further to 4,50,000 in 2015-16 and to 5,00 lakh in 2016-17. To achieve this target, all the Departments/ Organizations will have to plan and finalize their skill development initiatives to be achieved during the 12th Five Year Plan based on their presence in the various districts. They must keep in view the district wise skill gap survey report submitted by the NSDC while doing so.

I, therefore, request you to finalize the skill targets to be achieved during 2014-15, 2015-16 & 2016-17 based on the NSDC skill gap survey report for the State. Kindly also designate a Nodal Officer of your Department for skill development initiatives.
