Please refer to the subject cited above. The Department has finalized the following rates of subsidy on agricultural implements during the year 2017-18 under SMAM and other schemes. The approximate unit cost of each agricultural / horticultural implements and rate of subsidy applicable are as under:

The following terms and conditions shall be applicable for release of subsidy:

- 1) The rate of subsidy @ 50% of the cost of implement for SC/ST/SF/MF/W beneficiaries and @ 40% for others subject to a maximum limit mentioned against each implement as listed above whichever is lower will be applicable.
- 2) The bills raised after 01.04.2017 by the manufacturer / dealer / supplier shall be acceptable for grant of subsidy subject to the condition that the beneficiary farmer has made online application on the portal and finally got selected after due verification (till 20.08.2017).
- 3) It is further clarified that for farmers who have not participated on the online portal and have submitted their offline application at field offices after 20.08.2017 the due date of purchase of equipment will also be considered from 01.04.2017 onwards subject to availability of funds and final decision of the Department with respect to their eligibility in this regard.
- 4) The manufacturer / fabricators / suppliers available at the farmers portal of the GoI whose implements are tested by the Institutes approved by the GoI shall be eligible to supply the agricultural implements under the various schemes of agricultural mechanization. In this regard, an advertisement has been given in the newspapers to inform the manufacturers / fabricators who are not registered at the above portal for registration after testing of their implements at the approved institute of GoI.
- supplier shall have the authorization letter of that manufacturer. For the manufacturers who are registered with the farmer portal of the Govt. of India (www.farmer.gov.in) but have not uploaded the testing report of the implement on the same portal, all the purchase bills must be submitted along with the test report of the equipment / implement from any of the nodal testing institute mentioned under the SMAM Guidelines.
- 6) The manufacturer / fabricator shall provide the district wise list of distributor / dealer in the State of Haryana and also sale report of the implements sold in the

State in the year 2017-18 latest by 15th April, 2018. In case of supplier / dealer, the manufacturer shall also provide the supplier / dealer wise sale report of each implement with Sr. No. latest by 15th April, 2018 in the Directorate of Agriculture.

- 7) In case of supplier / dealer, it is mandatory to mention the name of manufacturer along with Sr. No. of agricultural implements in the bill raised. The bill raised by the dealer/supplier shall be attested by the authorized signatory of the manufacturer. The supplier / dealer shall also provide the district wise sale report implement wise to the Directorate of Agriculture latest by 15th April, 2018.
- 8) All the online applications received for availing the benefit of subsidy on agricultural implements may be exhausted first.
- 9) The number of verified farmers demanding agriculture implements rotavator in districts numbering less than 200 stands approved as verified till 20.08.2017 and will not be increased further in any way. For other districts where more than 200 applications stand verified for Rotavator, the number of beneficiary per district shall not exceed beyond 200 and draw of lot will be held to select the 200 beneficiaries out of the total verified applications / beneficiaries. Draw of lot will be held as per the procedure of the Department i.e. under the Chairmanship of the ADC.
- 10) No further application from farmers for the agriculture implement Rotavator will be accepted offline. The final decision on subsidy on rotavator will be taken after taking into account the status of fund available in future.
- 11) The farmers can submit the bill in the O/o DDA / AAE of the district up to 10.09.2017, for which an advertisement has been given in the newspapers (Hindi edition) immediately.
- 12) The AAEs must ensure that the physical verification of agricultural implements procured by the farmers may be completed by 20.09.2017. The joint verification will be carried out by the representative of DDA and AAE.
- 13) The physical verification of agricultural implements (at least 200 numbers) will be immediately carried out in the districts situated on GT Road belt for organizing Kisan Mela.
- 14) The requisite documents (5 nos.) along with bill of implement of the beneficiary farmers shall be uploaded at the Portal up to 31.12.2017 by concerned DDA / AAE.
- 15) The farmers will be free to purchase small implements costing up to Rs. 5000/- per implement from any vendor / fabricator available in the local market.
- 16) Mulcher may be included in the list of implements for establishment of CHCs which is effective for crop residue management.
- 17) The district Horticulture Officers will identify the farmers and shall submit the list of beneficiary farmers along with bill of implement and bank details after verification to the AAE concerned for release of subsidy.



18) The funds available under Administrative Cost under SMAM scheme shall be utilized towards purchase of computer / printer / salary of Office Associate / fuel etc.
